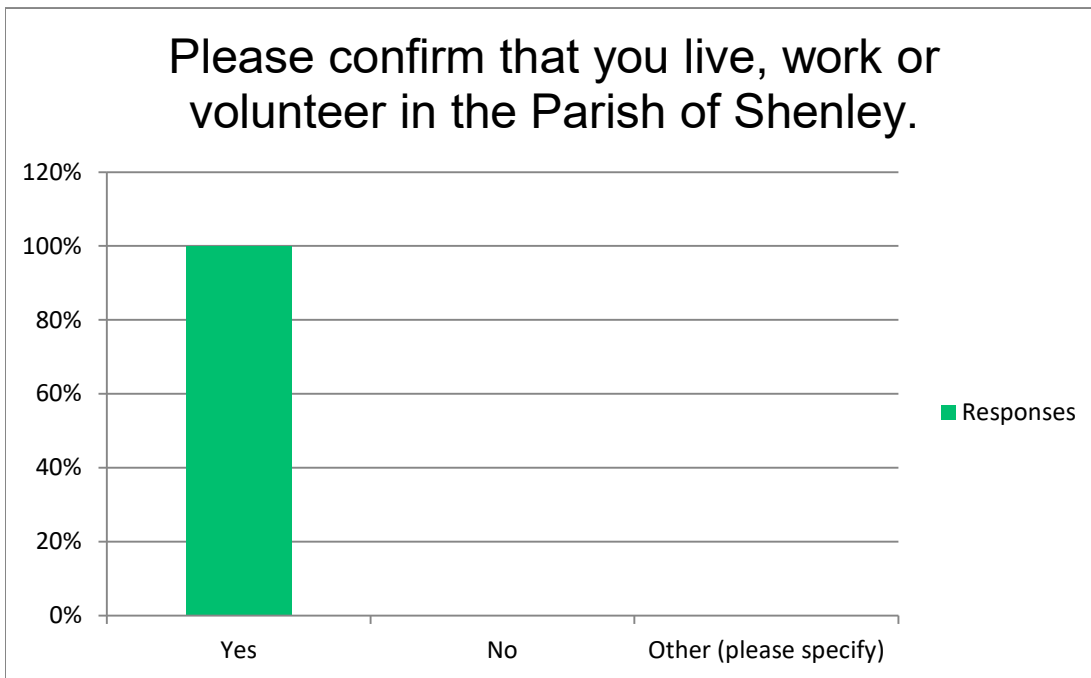

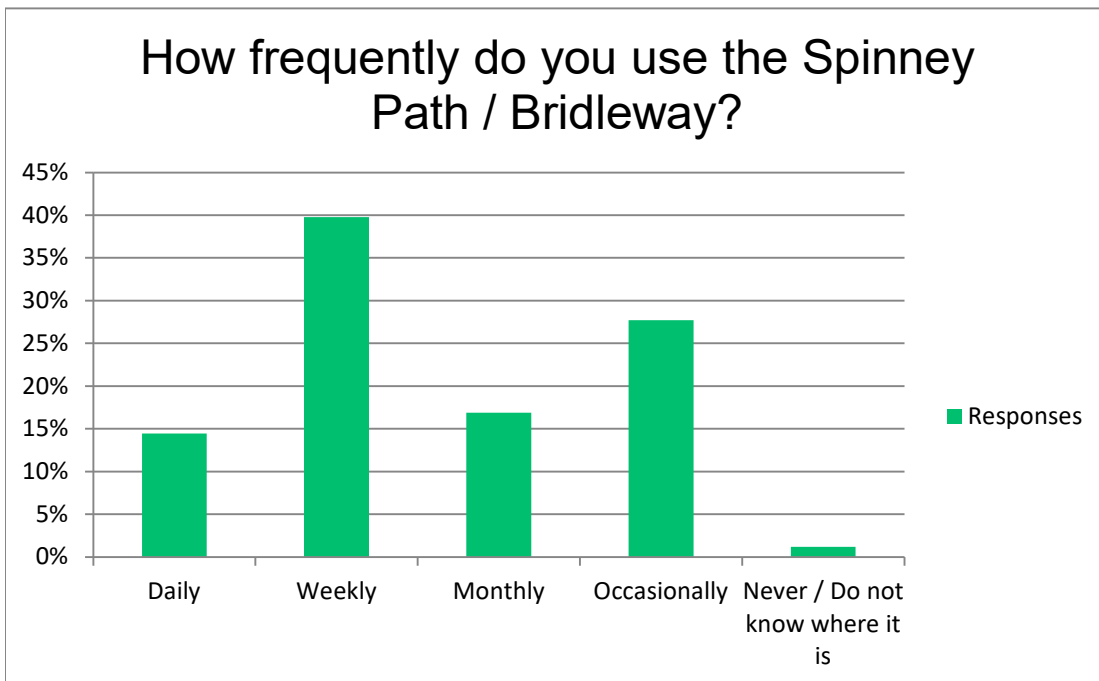
Which road/street do you live on?

How frequently do you use the Spinney Path / Bridleway?

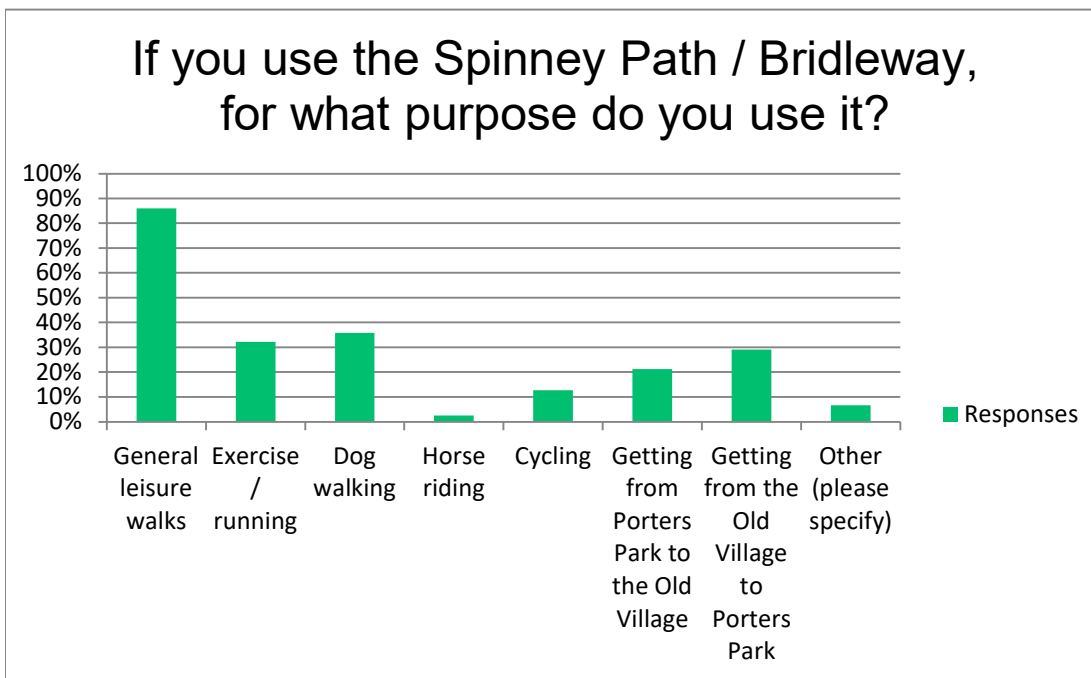

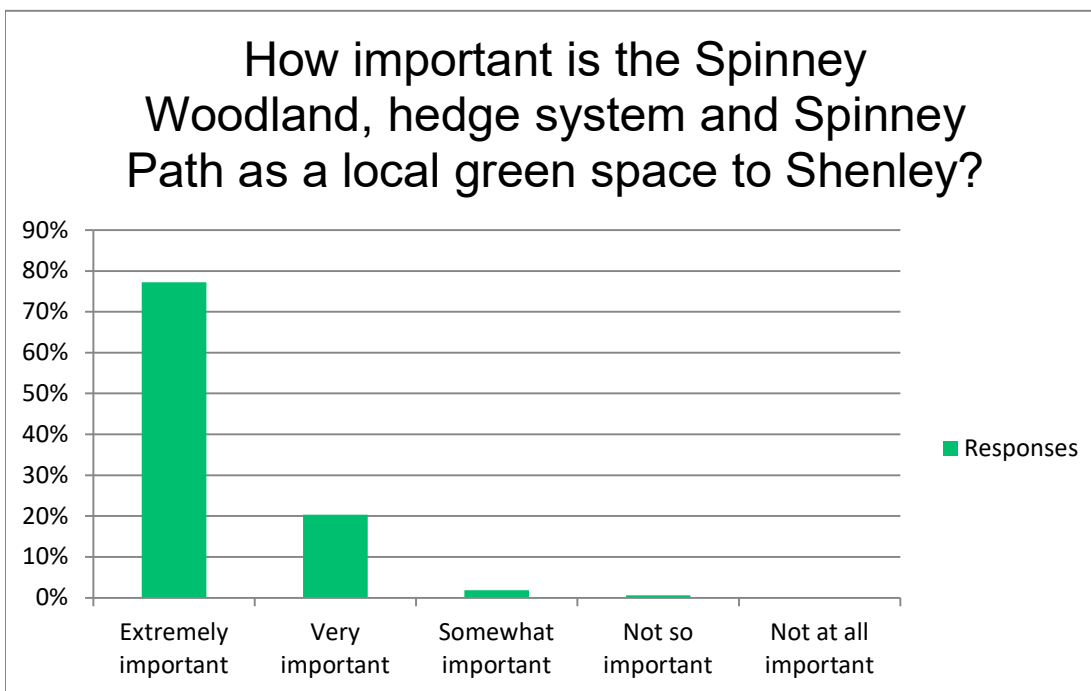

How important is the Spinney Woodland, hedge system and Spinney Path as a local green space to Shenley?

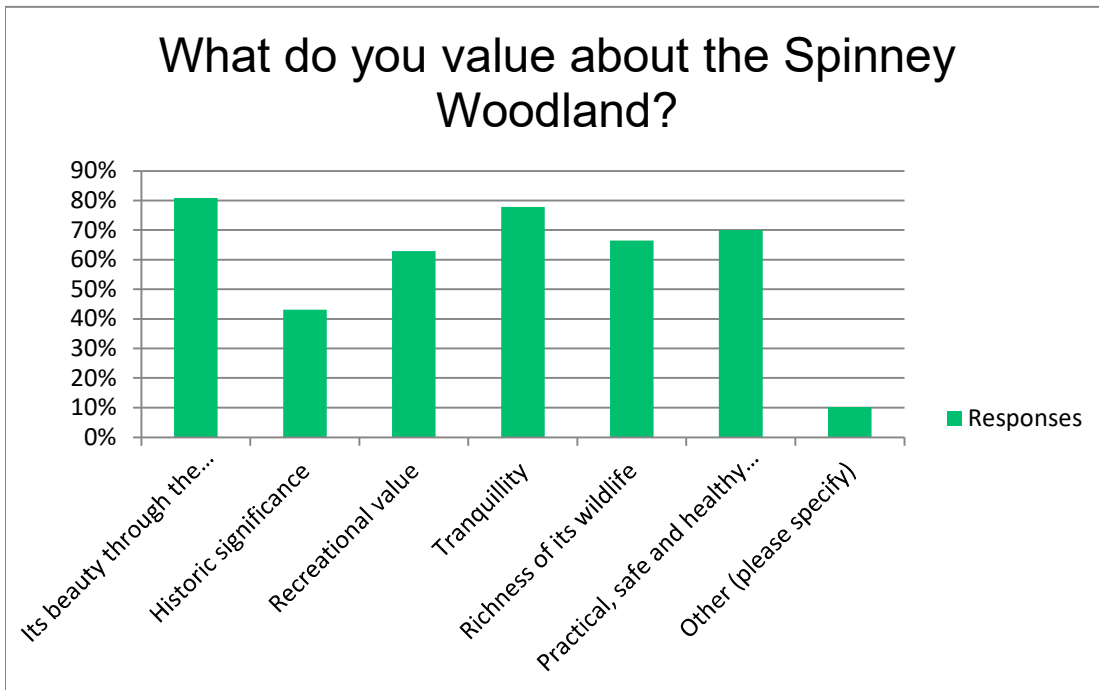

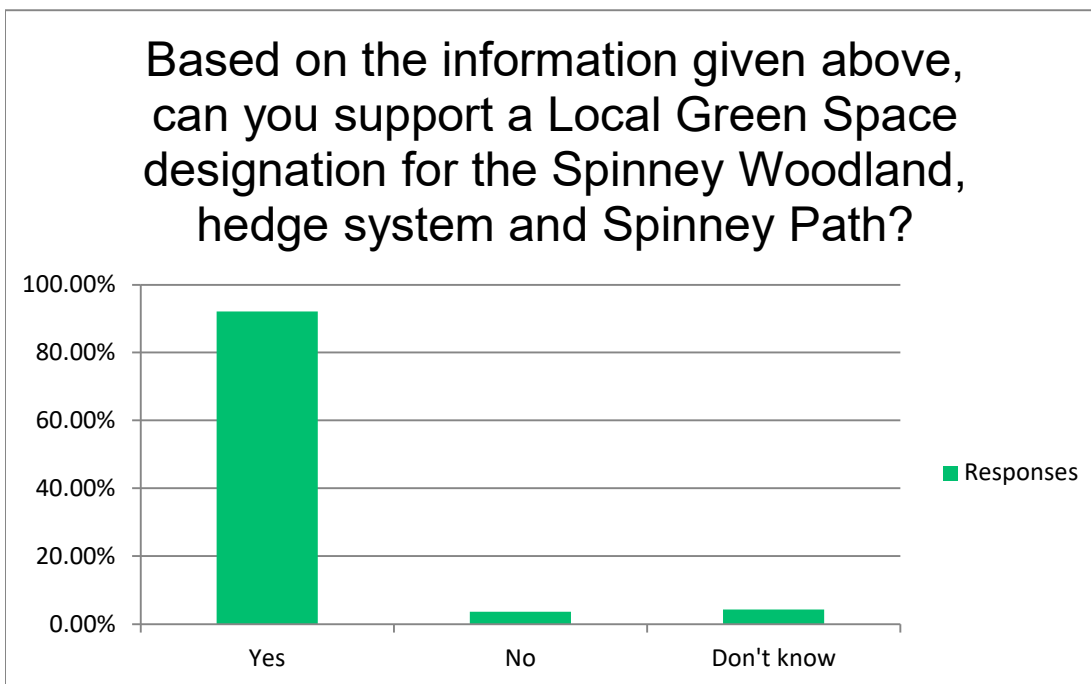
